4. Give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit, who lives in you. Let us keep in step with the Spirit. (Rom. 8:11; Gal. 5:25; 1 Pet. 3:18)
5. By the Spirit you put to death the misdeeds of the body. (Rom. 8:13; Gal. 5:16-17)
6. Those who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God. (Rom. 8:13-15; 7. By him (the Spirit) we cry Abba, Father. (Rom. 8:15; Gal. 4:6)
8. The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that we are God's children. (Rom. 8:16)

9. The Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us ... (Rom. 8:26-27)

Gen 1:2 Now the earth was formless and empty, darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the **Spirit** of God was hovering over the waters.

Gen 6:3 Then the LORD said, "My **Spirit** will not contend with man forever, for he is mortal; his days will be a hundred and twenty years."

Gen 41:38 So Pharaoh asked them, "Can we find anyone like this man, one in whom is the **spirit** of God?"

Exod 31:3 and I have filled him with the **Spirit** of God, with skill, ability and knowledge in all kinds of crafts--

Exod 35:31 and he has filled him with the **Spirit** of God, with skill, ability and knowledge in all kinds of crafts--

Num 11:17 I will come down and speak with you there, and I will take of the **Spirit** that is on you and put the **Spirit** on them. They will help you carry the burden of the people so that you will not have to carry it alone.

Num 11:25-26 Then the LORD came down in the cloud and spoke with him, and he took of the **Spirit** that was on him and put the **Spirit** on the seventy elders. When the **Spirit** rested on them, they prophesied, but they did not do so again. However, two men, whose names were Eldad and Medad, had remained in the camp. They were listed among the elders, but did not go out to the Tent. Yet the **Spirit** also rested on them, and they prophesied in the camp.

Num 11:29 But Moses replied, "Are you jealous for my sake? I wish that all the LORD's people were prophets and that the LORD would put his **Spirit** on them!"

Num 24:2 When Balaam looked out and saw Israel encamped tribe by tribe, the **Spirit** of God came upon him

Num 27:18 So the LORD said to Moses, "Take Joshua son of Nun, a man in whom is the **spirit**, and lay your hand on him.

Deut 34:9 Now Joshua son of Nun was filled with the **spirit** of wisdom because Moses had laid his hands on him. So the Israelites listened to him and did what the LORD had commanded Moses.

Judg 3:10 The **Spirit** of the LORD came upon him, so that he became Israel's judge and went to war. The LORD gave Cushan-Rishathaim king of Aram into the hands of Othniel, who overpowered him.

Judg 6:34 Then the **Spirit** of the LORD came upon Gideon, and he blew a trumpet, summoning the Abiezrites to follow him.

Judg 11:29 Then the **Spirit** of the LORD came upon Jephthah. He crossed Gilead and Manasseh, passed through Mizpah of Gilead, and from there he advanced against the Ammonites.

Judg 13:24-25 The woman gave birth to a boy and named him Samson. He grew and the LORD blessed him, and the **Spirit** of the LORD began to stir him while he was in Mahaneh Dan, between Zorah and Eshtaol.

Judg 14:6 The **Spirit** of the LORD came upon him in power so that he tore the lion apart with his bare hands as he might have torn a young goat. But he told neither his father nor his mother what he had done.

Judg 14:19 Then the **Spirit** of the LORD came upon him in power. He went down to Ashkelon, struck down thirty of their men, stripped them of their belongings and gave their clothes to those who had explained the riddle. Burning with anger, he went up to his father's house.

Judg 15:14 As he approached Lehi, the Philistines came toward him shouting. The **Spirit** of the LORD came upon him in power. The ropes on his arms became like charred flax, and the bindings dropped from his hands.

Judg 16:20 Then she called, "Samson, the Philistines are upon you!" He awoke from his sleep and thought, "I'll go out as before and shake myself free." But he did not know that **the LORD had left him**.

1 Sam 10:6 The **Spirit** of the LORD will come upon you in power, and you will prophesy with them; and you will be changed into a different person.

1 Sam 10:10 When they arrived at Gibeah, a procession of prophets met him; the **Spirit** of God came upon him in power, and he joined in their prophesying.

1 Sam 11:6 When Saul heard their words, the **Spirit** of God came upon him in power, and he burned with anger.

1 Sam 16:13 So Samuel took the horn of oil and anointed him in the presence of his brothers, and from that day on the **Spirit** of the LORD came upon David in power. Samuel then went to Ramah.

1 Sam 16:14 Now the **Spirit** of the LORD had departed from Saul, and an evil **spirit** from the LORD tormented him.

1 Sam 19:20 so he sent men to capture him. But when they saw a group of prophets prophesying, with Samuel standing there as their leader, the **Spirit** of God came upon Saul's men and they also prophesied.

1 Sam 19:23 So Saul went to Naioth at Ramah. But the **Spirit** of God came even upon him, and he walked along prophesying until he came to Naioth.

2 Sam 23:2 "The **Spirit** of the LORD spoke through me; his word was on my tongue.

I King 18:12 I don't know where the **Spirit** of the LORD may carry you when I leave you. If I go and tell Ahab and he doesn't find you, he will kill me. Yet I your servant have worshiped the LORD since my youth.

I King 22:24 Then Zedekiah son of Kenaanah went up and slapped Micaiah in the face. "Which way did the **spirit** from the LORD go when he went from me to speak to you?" he asked.

II Ki 2:9 When they had crossed, Elijah said to Elisha, "Tell me, what can I do for you before I am taken from you?" "Let me inherit a double portion of your **spirit**," Elisha replied.

II Ki 2:15 The company of the prophets from Jericho, who were watching, said, "The **spirit** of Elijah is resting on Elisha." And they went to meet him and bowed to the ground before him.

II Ki 2:16 "Look," they said, "we your servants have fifty able men. Let them go and look for your master. Perhaps the **Spirit** of the LORD has picked him up and set him down on some mountain or in some valley." "No," Elisha replied, "do not send them."

1 Chr 12:18 Then the **Spirit** came upon Amasai, chief of the Thirty, and he said: "We are yours, O David! We are with you, O son of Jesse! Success, success to you, and success to those who help you, for your God will help you." So David received them and made them leaders of his raiding bands.

1 Chr 28:12 He gave him the plans of all that the **Spirit** had put in his mind for the courts of the temple of the LORD and all the surrounding rooms, for the treasuries of the temple of God and for the treasuries for the dedicated things.

2 Chr 15:1 The **Spirit** of God came upon Azariah son of Oded.

2 Chr 18:23 Then Zedekiah son of Kenaanah went up and slapped Micaiah in the face. "Which way did the **spirit** from the LORD go when he went from me to speak to you?" he asked.

2 Chr 20:14 Then the **Spirit** of the LORD came upon Jahaziel son of Zechariah, the son of Benaiah, the son of Jeiel, the son of Mattaniah, a Levite and descendant of Asaph, as he stood in the assembly.

2 Chr 24:20 Then the **Spirit** of God came upon Zechariah son of Jehoiada the priest. He stood before the people and said, "This is what God says: 'Why do you disobey the LORD's commands? You will not prosper. Because you have forsaken the LORD, he has forsaken you.'"

Neh 9:20 You gave your good **Spirit** to instruct them. You did not withhold your manna from their mouths, and you gave them water for their thirst.

Neh 9:30 For many years you were patient with them. By your **Spirit** you admonished them through your prophets. Yet they paid no attention, so you handed them over to the neighboring peoples.

Job 33:4 The **Spirit** of God has made me; the breath of the Almighty gives me life.

Ps 51:11 Do not cast me from your presence or take your **Holy Spirit** from me.

Ps 104:30 When you send your **Spirit**, they are created, and you renew the face of the earth.

Ps 106:33 for they rebelled against the **Spirit** of God, and rash words came from Moses' lips.

Ps 139:7 Where can I go from your **Spirit**? Where can I flee from your presence?

Ps 143:10 Teach me to do your will, for you are my God; may your good **Spirit** lead me on level ground.

Isa 11:2 The **Spirit** of the LORD will rest on him-- the **Spirit** of wisdom and of understanding, the **Spirit** of counsel and of power, the **Spirit** of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD--

Isa 30:1 "Woe to the obstinate children," declares the LORD, "to those who carry out plans that are not mine, forming an alliance, but not by my **Spirit**, heaping sin upon sin;

Isa 32:15 till the **Spirit** is poured upon us from on high, and the desert becomes a fertile field, and the fertile field seems like a forest.

Isa 34:16 Look in the scroll of the LORD and read: None of these will be missing, not one will lack her mate. For it is his mouth that has given the order, and his **Spirit** will gather them together.

Isa 42:1 "Here is my servant, whom I uphold, my chosen one in whom I delight; I will put my **Spirit** on him and he will bring justice to the nations.

Isa 44:3 For I will pour water on the thirsty land, and streams on the dry ground; I will pour out my **Spirit** on your offspring, and my blessing on your descendants.

Isa 48:16 "Come near me and listen to this: "From the first announcement I have not spoken in secret; at the time it happens, I am there." And now the Sovereign LORD has sent me, with his **Spirit**.

Isa 59:21 "As for me, this is my covenant with them," says the LORD. "My **Spirit**, who is on you, and my words that I have put in your mouth will not depart from your mouth, or from the mouths of your children, or from the mouths of their descendants from this time on and forever," says the LORD.

Isa 61:1 The **Spirit** of the Sovereign LORD is on me, because the LORD has anointed me to preach good news to the poor. He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim freedom for the captives and release from darkness for the prisoners,

Isa 63:10 Yet they rebelled and grieved his **Holy Spirit**. So he turned and became their enemy and he himself fought against them.

Isa 63:11 Then his people recalled the days of old, the days of Moses and his people-- where is he who brought them through the sea, with the shepherd of his flock? Where is he who set his **Holy Spirit** among them,

Isa 63:14 like cattle that go down to the plain, they were given rest by the **Spirit** of the LORD. This is how you guided your people to make for yourself a glorious name.

Ezek 1:12 Each one went straight ahead. Wherever the **spirit** would go, they would go, without turning as they went.

Ezek 1:20 Wherever the **spirit** would go, they would go, and the wheels would rise along with them, because the **spirit** of the living creatures was in the wheels.

Ezek 1:21 When the creatures moved, they also moved; when the creatures stood still, they also stood still; and when the creatures rose from the ground, the wheels rose along with them, because the **spirit** of the living creatures was in the wheels.

Ezek 2:2 As he spoke, the **Spirit** came into me and raised me to my feet, and I heard him speaking to me.

Ezek 3:12 Then the **Spirit** lifted me up, and I heard behind me a loud rumbling sound-- May the glory of the LORD be praised in his dwelling place!--

Ezek 3:14 The **Spirit** then lifted me up and took me away, and I went in bitterness and in the anger of my **spirit**, with the strong hand of the LORD upon me.

Ezek 3:24 Then the **Spirit** came into me and raised me to my feet. He spoke to me and said: "Go, shut yourself inside your house.

Ezek 8:3 He stretched out what looked like a hand and took me by the hair of my head. The **Spirit** lifted me up between earth and heaven and in visions of God he took me to Jerusalem, to the entrance to the north gate of the inner court, where the idol that provokes to jealousy stood.

Ezek 10:17 When the cherubim stood still, they also stood still; and when the cherubim rose, they rose with them, because the **spirit** of the living creatures was in them.

Ezek 11:1 Then the **Spirit** lifted me up and brought me to the gate of the house of the LORD that faces east. There at the entrance to the gate were twenty-five men, and I saw among them Jaazaniah son of Azzur and Pelatiah son of Benaiah, leaders of the people.

Ezek 11:5 Then the **Spirit** of the LORD came upon me, and he told me to say: "This is what the LORD says: That is what you are saying, O house of Israel, but I know what is going through your mind.

Ezek 11:19 I will give them an undivided heart and put a new **spirit** in them; I will remove from them their heart of stone and give them a heart of flesh.

Ezek 11:24 The **Spirit** lifted me up and brought me to the exiles in Babylonia in the vision given by the **Spirit** of God. Then the vision I had seen went up from me,

Ezek 36:26 I will give you a new heart and put a new **spirit** in you; I will remove from you your heart of stone and give you a heart of flesh.

Ezek 36:27 And I will put my **Spirit** in you and move you to follow my decrees and be careful to keep my laws.

Ezek 37:1 The hand of the LORD was upon me, and he brought me out by the **Spirit** of the LORD and set me in the middle of a valley; it was full of bones.

Ezek 37:14 I will put my **Spirit** in you and you will live, and I will settle you in your own land. Then you will know that I the LORD have spoken, and I have done it, declares the LORD."

Ezek 39:29 I will no longer hide my face from them, for I will pour out my Spirit on the house of Israel, declares the Sovereign LORD."

Ezek 43:5 Then the **Spirit** lifted me up and brought me into the inner court, and the glory of the LORD filled the temple.

Dan 4:8 Finally, Daniel came into my presence and I told him the dream. (He is called Belteshazzar, after the name of my god, and the spirit of the holy gods is in him.)

Dan 4:9 I said, "Belteshazzar, chief of the magicians, I know that the **spirit** of the holy gods is in you, and no mystery is too difficult for you. Here is my dream; interpret it for me.

Dan 4:18 "This is the dream that I, King Nebuchadnezzar, had. Now, Belteshazzar, tell me what it means, for none of the wise men in my kingdom can interpret it for me. But you can, because the **spirit** of the holy gods is in you."

Dan 5:11 There is a man in your kingdom who has the **spirit** of the holy gods in him. In the time of your father he was found to have insight and intelligence and wisdom like that of the gods. King Nebuchadnezzar your father-- your father the king, I say-- appointed him chief of the magicians, enchanters, astrologers and diviners.

Dan 5:14 I have heard that the **spirit** of the gods is in you and that you have insight, intelligence and outstanding wisdom.

Joel 2:28-29 `And afterward, I will pour out my Spirit on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your old men will dream dreams, your young men will see visions. Even on my servants, both men and women, I will pour out my **Spirit** in those days.

Micah 2:7 Should it be said, O house of Jacob: "Is the Spirit of the LORD angry? Does he do such things?" "Do not my words do good to him whose ways are upright?"

Micah 3:8 But as for me, I am filled with power, with the Spirit of the LORD, and with justice and might, to declare to Jacob his transgression, to Israel his sin.

Hag 2:5 `This is what I covenanted with you when you came out of Egypt. And my Spirit remains among you. Do not fear.'

Zech 4:6 So he said to me, "This is the word of the LORD to Zerubbabel: `Not by might nor by power, but by my Spirit,' says the LORD Almighty.

Zech 6:8 Then he called to me, "Look, those going toward the north country have given my **Spirit** rest in the land of the north."

Zech 7:12 They made their hearts as hard as flint and would not listen to the law or to the words that the LORD Almighty had sent by his Spirit through the earlier prophets. So the LORD Almighty was very angry.

Matt 1:18 This is how the birth of Jesus Christ came about: His mother Mary was pledged to be married to Joseph, but before they came together, she was found to be with child through the **Holy Spirit**.

Matt 1:20 But after he had considered this, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said, "Joseph son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary home as your wife, because what is conceived in her is from the **Holy Spirit**.

Matt 3:11 "I baptize you with water for repentance. But after me will come one who is more powerful than I, whose sandals I am not fit to carry. He will baptize you with the **Holy Spirit** and with fire.

Matt 3:16 As soon as Jesus was baptized, he went up out of the water. At that moment heaven was opened, and he saw the **Spirit** of God descending like a dove and lighting on him.

Matt 4:1 Then Jesus was led by the **Spirit** into the desert to be tempted by the devil.

Matt 10:20 for it will not be you speaking, but the **Spirit** of your Father speaking through you.

Matt 12:18 "Here is my servant whom I have chosen, the one I love, in whom I delight; I will put my **Spirit** on him, and he will proclaim justice to the nations.

Matt 12:28 But if I drive out demons by the **Spirit** of God, then the kingdom of God has come upon you.

Matt 12:31 And so I tell you, every sin and blasphemy will be forgiven men, but the blasphemy against the **Spirit** will not be forgiven.

Matt 12:32 Anyone who speaks a word against the Son of Man will be forgiven, but anyone who speaks against the **Holy Spirit** will not be forgiven, either in this age or in the age to come.

Matt 22:43 He said to them, "How is it then that David, speaking by the **Spirit**, calls him `Lord`?" For he says,

Matt 28:19 Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the **Holy Spirit**,

Mark 1:8 I baptize you with water, but he will baptize you with the **Holy Spirit**."

Mark 1:10 As Jesus was coming up out of the water, he saw heaven being torn open and the **Spirit** descending on him like a dove.

Mark 1:12 At once the **Spirit** sent him out into the desert,

Mark 3:29 But whoever blasphemes against the **Holy Spirit** will never be forgiven; he is guilty of an eternal sin."

Mark 12:36 David himself, speaking by the **Holy Spirit**, declared: "The Lord said to my Lord: "Sit at my right hand until I put your enemies under your feet." "

Mark 13:11 Whenever you are arrested and brought to trial, do not worry beforehand about what to say. Just say whatever is given you at the time, for it is not you speaking, but the **Holy Spirit**.

Luke 1:15 for he will be great in the sight of the Lord. He is never to take wine or other fermented drink, and he will be filled with the **Holy Spirit** even from birth.

Luke 1:35 The angel answered, "The **Holy Spirit** will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. So the holy one to be born will be called the Son of God.

Luke 1:41 When Elizabeth heard Mary's greeting, the baby leaped in her womb, and Elizabeth was filled with the **Holy Spirit**.

Luke 1:67 His father Zechariah was filled with the **Holy Spirit** and prophesied:

Luke 2:25 Now there was a man in Jerusalem called Simeon, who was righteous and devout. He was waiting for the consolation of Israel, and the **Holy Spirit** was upon him.

Luke 2:26 It had been revealed to him by the **Holy Spirit** that he would not die before he had seen the Lord's Christ.

Luke 2:27 Moved by the **Spirit**, he went into the temple courts. When the parents brought in the child Jesus to do for him what the custom of the Law required,

Luke 3:16 John answered them all, "I baptize you with water. But one more powerful than I will come, the thongs of whose sandals I am not worthy to untie. He will baptize you with the **Holy Spirit** and with fire.

Luke 3:22 and the **Holy Spirit** descended on him in bodily form like a dove. And a voice came from heaven: "You are my Son, whom I love; with you I am well pleased."

Luke 4:1 Jesus, full of the **Holy Spirit**, returned from the Jordan and was led by the **Spirit** in the desert,

Luke 4:14 Jesus returned to Galilee in the power of the **Spirit**, and news about him spread through the whole countryside.

Luke 4:18 "The **Spirit** of the Lord is on me, because he has anointed me to preach good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim freedom for the prisoners and recovery of sight for the blind, to release the oppressed,

Luke 10:21 At that time Jesus, full of joy through the **Holy Spirit**, said, "I praise you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because you have hidden these things from the wise and learned, and revealed them to little children. Yes, Father, for this was your good pleasure.

Luke 11:13 If you then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give the **Holy Spirit** to those who ask him!"

Luke 12:10 And everyone who speaks a word against the Son of Man will be forgiven, but anyone who blasphemes against the **Holy Spirit** will not be forgiven.

Luke 12:12 for the **Holy Spirit** will teach you at that time what you should say."

John 1:32 Then John gave this testimony: "I saw the **Spirit** come down from heaven as a dove and remain on him.

John 1:33 I would not have known him, except that the one who sent me to baptize with water told me, 'The man on whom you see the **Spirit** come down and remain is he who will baptize with the **Holy Spirit**.'

John 3:5 Jesus answered, "I tell you the truth, no one can enter the kingdom of God unless he is born of water and the **Spirit**.

John 3:6 Flesh gives birth to flesh, but the **Spirit** gives birth to **spirit**.

John 3:8 The wind blows wherever it pleases. You hear its sound, but you cannot tell where it comes from or where it is going. So it is with everyone born of the **Spirit**."

John 3:34 For the one whom God has sent speaks the words of God, for God gives the **Spirit** without limit.

John 4:23 Yet a time is coming and has now come when the true worshipers will worship the Father in **spirit** and truth, for they are the kind of worshipers the Father seeks.

John 4:24 God is **spirit**, and his worshipers must worship in **spirit** and in truth."

John 6:63 The **Spirit** gives life; the flesh counts for nothing. The words I have spoken to you are **spirit** and they are life.

John 7:39 By this he meant the **Spirit**, whom those who believed in him were later to receive. Up to that time the **Spirit** had not been given, since Jesus had not yet been glorified.

John 14:16-18

And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another **Counselor** to be with you forever--the Spirit of truth. The world cannot accept him, because it neither sees him nor knows him. But you know him, for he lives with you and will be in you. I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you.

John 14:26 But the Counselor, the **Holy Spirit**, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you.

John 15:26 "When the Counselor comes, whom I will send to you from the Father, the **Spirit** of truth who goes out from the Father, he will testify about me.

John 16:7-13 But I tell you the truth: It is for your good that I am going away. Unless I go away, **the Counselor** will not come to you; but if I go, I will send him to you. When he comes, he will convict the world of guilt in regard to sin and righteousness and judgment: in regard to sin, because men do not believe in me; in regard to righteousness, because I am going to the Father, where you can see me no longer; and in regard to judgment, because the prince of this world now stands condemned. "I have much more to say to you, more than you can now bear. But when he, the **Spirit** of truth, comes, he will guide you into all truth. He will not speak on his own; he will speak only what he hears, and he will tell you what is yet to come.

John 16:15 All that belongs to the Father is mine. That is why I said the **Spirit** will take from what is mine and make it known to you.

John 20:22 And with that he breathed on them and said, "Receive the **Holy Spirit**."

Acts 1:2 until the day he was taken up to heaven, after giving instructions through the **Holy Spirit** to the apostles he had chosen.

Acts 1:5 For John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the **Holy Spirit**."

Acts 1:8 But you will receive power when the **Holy Spirit** comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."

Acts 1:16 and said, "Brothers, the Scripture had to be fulfilled which the **Holy Spirit** spoke long ago through the mouth of David concerning Judas, who served as guide for those who arrested Jesus--

Acts 2:1-4 When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place. Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. All of them were filled with the **Holy Spirit** and began to speak in other tongues as the **Spirit** enabled them.

Acts 2:16-18 No, this is what was spoken by the prophet Joel: "In the last days, God says, I will pour out my **Spirit** on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your young men will see visions, your old men will dream dreams. Even on my servants, both men and women, I will pour out my **Spirit** in those days, and they will prophesy."

Acts 2:33 Exalted to the right hand of God, he has received from the Father the promised **Holy Spirit** and has poured out what you now see and hear.

Acts 2:38-39 Peter replied, "Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the **Holy Spirit**. The promise is for you and your children and for all who are far off-- for all whom the Lord our God will call."

Acts 4:8 Then Peter, filled with the **Holy Spirit**, said to them: "Rulers and elders of the people!

Acts 4:25 You spoke by the **Holy Spirit** through the mouth of your servant, our father David: "Why do the nations rage and the peoples plot in vain?

Acts 4:31 After they prayed, the place where they were meeting was shaken. And they were all filled with the **Holy Spirit** and spoke the word of God boldly.

Acts 5:3-4 Then Peter said, "Ananias, how is it that Satan has so filled your heart that you have lied to the **Holy Spirit** and have kept for yourself some of the money you received for the land? Didn't it belong to you before it was sold? And after it was sold, wasn't the money at your disposal? What made you think of doing such a thing? You have not lied to men but to God."

Acts 5:9 Peter said to her, "How could you agree to test the **Spirit** of the Lord? Look! The feet of the men who buried your husband are at the door, and they will carry you out also."

Acts 5:32 We are witnesses of these things, and so is the **Holy Spirit**, whom God has given to those who obey him."

Acts 6:3 Brothers, choose seven men from among you who are known to be full of the **Spirit** and wisdom. We will turn this responsibility over to them

Acts 6:5 This proposal pleased the whole group. They chose Stephen, a man full of faith and of the **Holy Spirit**; also Philip, Procorus, Nicanor, Timon, Parmenas, and Nicolas from Antioch, a convert to Judaism.

Acts 6:10 but they could not stand up against his wisdom or the **Spirit** by whom he spoke.

Acts 7:51 "You stiff-necked people, with uncircumcised hearts and ears! You are just like your fathers: You always resist the **Holy Spirit!**

Acts 7:55 But Stephen, full of the **Holy Spirit**, looked up to heaven and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing at the right hand of God.

Acts 8:15-17 When they arrived, they prayed for them that they might receive the **Holy Spirit**, because the **Holy Spirit** had not yet come upon any of them; they had simply been baptized into the name of the Lord Jesus. Then Peter and John placed their hands on them, and they received the **Holy Spirit**.

Acts 8:18-19 When Simon saw that the **Spirit** was given at the laying on of the apostles' hands, he offered them money and said, "Give me also this ability so that everyone on whom I lay my hands may receive the **Holy Spirit**."

Acts 8:29 The **Spirit** told Philip, "Go to that chariot and stay near it."

Acts 8:39 When they came up out of the water, the **Spirit** of the Lord suddenly took Philip away, and the eunuch did not see him again, but went on his way rejoicing.

Acts 9:17 Then Ananias went to the house and entered it. Placing his hands on Saul, he said, "Brother Saul, the Lord-- Jesus, who appeared to you on the road as you were coming here-- has sent me so that you may see again and be filled with the **Holy Spirit**."

Acts 9:31 Then the church throughout Judea, Galilee and Samaria enjoyed a time of peace. It was strengthened; and encouraged by the **Holy Spirit**, it grew in numbers, living in the fear of the Lord.

Acts 10:19 While Peter was still thinking about the vision, the **Spirit** said to him, "Simon, three men are looking for you.

Acts 10:38 how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the **Holy Spirit** and power, and how he went around doing good and healing all who were under the power of the devil, because God was with him.

Acts 10:44 While Peter was still speaking these words, the **Holy Spirit** came on all who heard the message.

Acts 10:45-47 The circumcised believers who had come with Peter were astonished that the gift of the **Holy Spirit** had been poured out even on the Gentiles. For they heard them speaking in tongues and praising God. Then Peter said, "Can anyone keep these people from being baptized with water? They have received the **Holy Spirit** just as we have."

Acts 11:12 The **Spirit** told me to have no hesitation about going with them. These six brothers also went with me, and we entered the man's house.

Acts 11:15-16 "As I began to speak, the **Holy Spirit** came on them as he had come on us at the beginning. Then I remembered what the Lord had said: `John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the **Holy Spirit**.'"

Acts 11:24 He (Barnabas) was a good man, full of the **Holy Spirit** and faith, and a great number of people were brought to the Lord.

Acts 11:28 One of them, named Agabus, stood up and through the **Spirit** predicted that a severe famine would spread over the entire Roman world. (This happened during the reign of Claudius.)

Acts 13:2 While they were worshiping the Lord and fasting, the **Holy Spirit** said, "Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them."

Acts 13:4 The two of them, sent on their way by the **Holy Spirit**, went down to Seleucia and sailed from there to Cyprus.

Acts 13:9 Then Saul, who was also called Paul, filled with the **Holy Spirit**, looked straight at Elymas and said,

Acts 13:52 And the disciples were filled with joy and with the **Holy Spirit**.

Acts 15:8 God, who knows the heart, showed that he accepted them by giving the **Holy Spirit** to them, just as he did to us.

Acts 15:28 It seemed good to the **Holy Spirit** and to us not to burden you with anything beyond the following requirements:

Acts 16:6 Paul and his companions traveled throughout the region of Phrygia and Galatia, having been kept by the **Holy Spirit** from preaching the word in the province of Asia.

Acts 16:7 When they came to the border of Mysia, they tried to enter Bithynia, but the **Spirit** of Jesus would not allow them to.

Acts 19:2 and asked them, "Did you receive the **Holy Spirit** when you believed?" They answered, "No, we have not even heard that there is a **Holy Spirit**."

Acts 19:6 When Paul placed his hands on them, the **Holy Spirit** came on them, and they spoke in tongues and prophesied.

Acts 20:22 "And now, compelled by the **Spirit**, I am going to Jerusalem, not knowing what will happen to me there.

Acts 20:23 I only know that in every city the **Holy Spirit** warns me that prison and hardships are facing me.

Acts 20:28 Keep watch over yourselves and all the flock of which the **Holy Spirit** has made you overseers. Be shepherds of the church of God, which he bought with his own blood.

Acts 21:4 Finding the disciples there, we stayed with them seven days. Through the **Spirit** they urged Paul not to go on to Jerusalem.

Acts 21:11 Coming over to us, he took Paul's belt, tied his own hands and feet with it and said, "The **Holy Spirit** says, 'In this way the Jews of Jerusalem will bind

the owner of this belt and will hand him over to the Gentiles.'"

Acts 28:25 They disagreed among themselves and began to leave after Paul had made this final statement: "The **Holy Spirit** spoke the truth to your forefathers when he said through Isaiah the prophet:

Rom 1:4 and who through the **Spirit** of holiness was declared with power to be the Son of God by his resurrection from the dead: Jesus Christ our Lord.

Rom 2:29 No, a man is a Jew if he is one inwardly; and circumcision is circumcision of the heart, by the **Spirit**, not by the written code. Such a man's praise is not from men, but from God.

Rom 5:5 And hope does not disappoint us, because God has poured out his love into our hearts by the **Holy Spirit**, whom he has given us.

Rom 7:6 But now, by dying to what once bound us, we have been released from the law so that we serve in the new way of the **Spirit**, and not in the old way of the written code.

Rom 8:2 because through Christ Jesus the law of the **Spirit** of life set me free from the law of sin and death.

Rom 8:4-6 in order that the righteous requirements of the law might be fully met in us, who do not live according to the sinful nature but according to the **Spirit**. Those who live according to the sinful nature have their minds set on what that nature desires; but those who live in accordance with the **Spirit** have their minds set on what the **Spirit** desires. The mind of sinful man is death, but the mind controlled by the **Spirit** is life and peace;

Rom 8:9 You, however, are controlled not by the sinful nature but by the **Spirit**, if the **Spirit** of God lives in you. And if anyone does not have the **Spirit** of Christ, he does not belong to Christ.

Rom 8:11 And if the **Spirit** of him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, he who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through his **Spirit**, who lives in you.

Rom 8:13-15 For if you live according to the sinful nature, you will die; but if by the **Spirit** you put to death the misdeeds of the body, you will live, because those who are led by the **Spirit** of God are sons of God. For you did not receive a **spirit** that makes you a slave again to fear, but you received the **Spirit** of sonship. And by him we cry, "Abba, Father."

Rom 8:16 The **Spirit** himself testifies with our **spirit** that we are God's children.

Rom 8:23 Not only so, but we ourselves, who have the firstfruits of the **Spirit**, groan inwardly as we wait eagerly for our adoption as sons, the redemption of our bodies.

Rom 8:26-27 In the same way, the **Spirit** helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the **Spirit** himself intercedes for us with groans that words cannot express. And he who searches our hearts knows the mind of the **Spirit**, because the **Spirit** intercedes for the saints in accordance with God's will.

Rom 9:1 I speak the truth in Christ-- I am not lying, my conscience confirms it in the **Holy Spirit**--

Rom 14:17 For the kingdom of God is not a matter of eating and drinking, but of righteousness, peace and joy in the **Holy Spirit**,

Rom 15:5 May the God who gives endurance and encouragement give you a **spirit** of unity among yourselves as you follow Christ Jesus,

Rom 15:13 May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the **Holy Spirit**.

Rom 15:16 to be a minister of Christ Jesus to the Gentiles with the priestly duty of proclaiming the gospel of God, so that the Gentiles might become an offering acceptable to God, sanctified by the **Holy Spirit**.

Rom 15:19 by the power of signs and miracles, through the power of the **Spirit**. So from Jerusalem all the way around to Illyricum, I have fully proclaimed the gospel of Christ.

Rom 15:30 I urge you, brothers, by our Lord Jesus Christ and by the love of the **Spirit**, to join me in my struggle by praying to God for me.

1 Cor 2:10-11 but God has revealed it to us by his **Spirit**. The **Spirit** searches all things, even the deep things of God. For who among men knows the thoughts of a man except the man's **spirit** within him? In the same way no one knows the thoughts of God except the **Spirit** of God.

1 Cor 2:12-13 We have not received the **spirit** of the world but the **Spirit** who is from God, that we may understand what God has freely given us. This is what we speak, not in words taught us by human wisdom but in words taught by the **Spirit**, expressing **spiritual** truths in **spiritual** words. The man without the **Spirit** does not accept the things that come from the **Spirit** of God, for they are foolishness to him, and he cannot understand them, because they are **spiritually** discerned.

1 Cor 3:16 Don't you know that you yourselves are God's temple and that God's **Spirit** lives in you?

1 Cor 6:11 And that is what some of you were. But you were washed, you were sanctified, you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and by the **Spirit** of our God.

1 Cor 6:17 But he who unites himself with the Lord is one with him in **spirit**.

1 Cor 6:19 Do you not know that your body is a temple of the **Holy Spirit**, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own;

1 Cor 7:40 In my judgment, she is happier if she stays as she is-- and I think that I too have the **Spirit** of God.

1 Cor 12:3 Therefore I tell you that no one who is speaking by the **Spirit** of God says, "Jesus be cursed," and no one can say, "Jesus is Lord," except by the **Holy Spirit**.

1 Cor 12:4 There are different kinds of gifts, but the same **Spirit**.

1 Cor 12:7-9 Now to each one the manifestation of the **Spirit** is given for the common good. To one there is given through the **Spirit** the message of wisdom, to another the message of knowledge by means of the same **Spirit**, to another faith by the same **Spirit**, to another gifts of healing by that one **Spirit**,

1 Cor 12:11 All these are the work of one and the same **Spirit**, and he gives them to each one, just as he determines.

1 Cor 12:13 For we were all baptized by one **Spirit** into one body-- whether Jews or Greeks, slave or free-- and we were all given the one **Spirit** to drink.

2 Cor 1:22 set his seal of ownership on us, and put his **Spirit** in our hearts as a deposit, guaranteeing what is to come.

2 Cor 3:3 You show that you are a letter from Christ, the result of our ministry, written not with ink but with the **Spirit** of the living God, not on tablets of stone but on tablets of human hearts.

2 Cor 3:6 He has made us competent as ministers of a new covenant-- not of the letter but of the **Spirit**; for the letter kills, but the **Spirit** gives life.

2 Cor 3:8 will not the ministry of the **Spirit** be even more glorious?

2 Cor 3:17 Now the Lord is the **Spirit**, and where the **Spirit** of the Lord is, there is freedom. And we, who with unveiled faces all reflect the Lord's glory, are being transformed into his likeness with ever-increasing glory, which comes from the Lord, who is the **Spirit**.

2 Cor 5:5 Now it is God who has made us for this very purpose and has given us the **Spirit** as a deposit, guaranteeing what is to come.

2 Cor 6:4-6 Rather, as servants of God we commend ourselves in every way: in great endurance; in troubles, hardships and distresses ... in purity, understanding, patience and kindness; in the **Holy Spirit** and in sincere love;

2 Cor 13:14 May the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the **Holy Spirit** be with you all.

Gal 3:2-5 I would like to learn just one thing from you: Did you receive the **Spirit** by observing the law, or by believing what you heard? Are you so foolish? After beginning with the **Spirit**, are you now trying to attain your goal by human effort? Have you suffered so much for nothing-- if it really was for nothing? Does God give you his **Spirit** and work miracles among you because you observe the law, or because you believe what you heard?

Gal 3:14 He redeemed us in order that the blessing given to Abraham might come to the Gentiles through Christ Jesus, so that by faith we might receive the promise of the **Spirit**.

Gal 4:6 Because you are sons, God sent the **Spirit** of his Son into our hearts, the **Spirit** who calls out, "Abba, Father."

Gal 4:29 At that time the son born in the ordinary way persecuted the son born by the power of the **Spirit**. It is the same now.

Gal 5:5 But by faith we eagerly await through the **Spirit** the righteousness for which we hope.

Gal 5:16-17 So I say, live by the **Spirit**, and you will not gratify the desires of the sinful nature. For the sinful nature desires what is contrary to the **Spirit**, and the **Spirit** what is contrary to the sinful nature. They are in conflict with each other, so that you do not do what you want.

Gal 5:18 But if you are led by the **Spirit**, you are not under law.

Gal 5:22 But the fruit of the **Spirit** is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,

Gal 5:25 Since we live by the **Spirit**, let us keep in step with the **Spirit**.

Gal 6:8 The one who sows to please his sinful nature, from that nature will reap destruction; the one who sows to please the **Spirit**, from the **Spirit** will reap eternal life.

Eph 1:13-14 And you also were included in Christ when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation. Having believed, you were marked in him with a seal, the promised **Holy Spirit**, who is a deposit guaranteeing our inheritance until the redemption of those who are God's possession-- to the praise of his glory.

Eph 1:17 I keep asking that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, may give you the **Spirit** of wisdom and revelation, so that you may know him better.

Eph 2:18 For through him we both have access to the Father by one **Spirit**.

Eph 2:22 And in him you too are being built together to become a dwelling in which God lives by his **Spirit**.

Eph 3:5 which was not made known to men in other generations as it has now been revealed by the **Spirit** to God's holy apostles and prophets.

Eph 3:16-17 I pray that out of his glorious riches he may strengthen you with power through his **Spirit** in your inner being, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith. And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love,

Eph 4:3-4 Make every effort to keep the unity of the **Spirit** through the bond of peace. There is one body and one **Spirit**-- just as you were called to one hope when you were called--

Eph 4:30 And do not grieve the **Holy Spirit** of God, with whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.

Eph 5:18-21 Do not get drunk on wine, which leads to debauchery. Instead, be filled with the **Spirit**. Speak to one another with psalms, hymns and spiritual songs. Sing and make music in your heart to the Lord, always giving thanks to God the Father for everything, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. Submit to one another out of reverence for Christ.

Eph 6:17-18 Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the **Spirit**, which is the word of God. And pray in the **Spirit** on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and

requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the saints.

Phil 1:19 for I know that through your prayers and the help given by the **Spirit** of Jesus Christ, what has happened to me will turn out for my deliverance.

Phil 2:1-2 If you have any encouragement from being united with Christ, if any comfort from his love, if any fellowship with the **Spirit**, if any tenderness and compassion, then make my joy complete by being like-minded, having the same love, being one in **spirit** and purpose.

Phil 3:3 For it is we who are the circumcision, we who worship by the **Spirit** of God, who glory in Christ Jesus, and who put no confidence in the flesh--

Col 1:8 and who also told us of your love in the **Spirit**.

1Thes 1:5 because our gospel came to you not simply with words, but also with power, with the **Holy Spirit** and with deep conviction. You know how we lived among you for your sake.

1Thes 1:6 You became imitators of us and of the Lord; in spite of severe suffering, you welcomed the message with the joy given by the **Holy Spirit**.

1Thes 4:8 Therefore, he who rejects this instruction does not reject man but God, who gives you his **Holy Spirit**.

1 Thes 5:19 Do not put out the Spirit's fire.

II Th 2:13 But we ought always to thank God for you, brothers loved by the Lord, because from the beginning God chose you to be saved through the sanctifying work of the **Spirit** and through belief in the truth.

1 Tim 3:16 Beyond all question, the mystery of godliness is great: He appeared in a body, was vindicated by the **Spirit**, was seen by angels, was preached among the nations, was believed on in the world, was taken up in glory.

1 Tim 4:1 The **Spirit** clearly says that in later times some will abandon the faith and follow deceiving **spirits** and things taught by demons.

2 Tim 1:7 For God did not give us a **spirit** of timidity, but a **spirit** of power, of love and of self-discipline.

2 Tim 1:14 Guard the good deposit that was entrusted to you-- guard it with the help of the **Holy Spirit** who lives in us.

Titus 3:5-7 he saved us, not because of righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy. He saved us through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the **Holy Spirit**, whom he poured out on us generously through Jesus Christ our Savior, so that, having been justified by his grace, we might become heirs having the hope of eternal life.

Heb 2:4 God also testified to it by signs, wonders and various miracles, and gifts of the **Holy Spirit** distributed according to his will.

Heb 3:7-9 So, as the **Holy Spirit** says: "Today, if you hear his voice, do not harden your hearts as you did in the rebellion, during the time of testing in the desert, where your fathers tested and tried me and for forty years saw what I did.

Heb 6:4-6 It is impossible for those who have once been enlightened, who have tasted the heavenly gift, who have shared in the **Holy Spirit**, who have tasted the goodness of the word of God and the powers of the coming age, if they fall away, to be brought back to repentance, because to their loss they are crucifying the Son of God all over again and subjecting him to public disgrace.

Heb 9:8 The **Holy Spirit** was showing by this that the way into the Most **Holy** Place had not yet been disclosed as long as the first tabernacle was still standing.

Heb 9:14 How much more, then, will the blood of Christ, who through the **eternal Spirit** offered himself unblemished to God, cleanse our consciences from acts that lead to death, so that we may serve the living God!

Heb 10:15-17 The **Holy Spirit** also testifies to us about this. First he says: "This is the covenant I will make with them after that time, says the Lord. I will put my laws in their hearts, and I will write them on their minds." Then he adds: "Their sins and lawless acts I will remember no more."

Heb 10:29 How much more severely do you think a man deserves to be

punished who has trampled the Son of God under foot, who has treated as an unholy thing the blood of the covenant that sanctified him, and who has insulted the Spirit of grace?

James 4:5 Or do you think Scripture says without reason that the spirit he caused to live in us envies intensely?

1 Pet 1:2 who have been chosen according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, through the sanctifying work of the Spirit, for obedience to Jesus Christ and sprinkling by his blood: Grace and peace be yours in abundance.

1 Pet 1:11-12 trying to find out the time and circumstances to which the Spirit of Christ in them was pointing when he predicted the sufferings of Christ and the glories that would follow. It was revealed to them that they were not serving themselves but you, when they spoke of the things that have now been told you by those who have preached the gospel to you by the Holy Spirit sent from heaven. Even angels long to look into these things.

1 Pet 3:18 For Christ died for sins once for all, the righteous for the unrighteous, to bring you to God. He was put to death in the body but made alive by the Spirit,

1 Pet 4:6 For this is the reason the gospel was preached even to those who are now dead, so that they might be judged according to men in regard to the body, but live according to God in regard to the spirit.

1 Pet 4:14 If you are insulted because of the name of Christ, you are blessed, for the Spirit of glory and of God rests on you.

2 Pet 1:21 For prophecy never had its origin in the will of man, but men spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit.

I Jn 3:24 Those who obey his commands live in him, and he in them. And this is how we know that he lives in us: We know it by the Spirit he gave us.

I Jn 4:1-3 Dear friends, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see whether they are from God, because many false prophets have gone out into the world. This is how you can recognize the Spirit of God: Every spirit that acknowledges that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is from God, but every spirit that does not acknowledge Jesus is not from God. This is the spirit of the antichrist, which you have heard is coming and even now is already in the world.

I Jn 4:6 We are from God, and whoever knows God listens to us; but whoever is not from God does not listen to us. This is how we recognize the Spirit of truth and the spirit of falsehood.

I Jn 4:13 We know that we live in him and he in us, because he has given us of his Spirit.

I Jn 5:6-8 This is the one who came by water and blood-- Jesus Christ. He did not come by water only, but by water and blood. And it is the Spirit who testifies, because the Spirit is the truth. For there are three that testify: the Spirit, the water and the blood; and the three are in agreement.

Jude 1:19-20 These are the men who divide you, who follow mere natural instincts and do not have the Spirit. But

you, dear friends, build yourselves up in your most holy faith and pray in the Holy Spirit.

Rev 1:10 On the Lord's Day I was in the Spirit, and I heard behind me a loud voice like a trumpet,

Rev 2:7 He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. To him who overcomes, I will give the right to eat from the tree of life, which is in the paradise of God.

Rev 2:11 He who has an ear, let him hear what the **Spirit** says to the churches. He who overcomes will not be hurt at all by the second death.

Rev 2:17 He who has an ear, let him hear what the **Spirit** says to the churches. To him who overcomes, I will give some of the hidden manna. I will also give him a white stone with a new name written on it, known only to him who receives it.

Rev 2:29 He who has an ear, let him hear what the **Spirit** says to the churches.

Rev 3:6 He who has an ear, let him hear what the **Spirit** says to the churches.

Rev 3:13 He who has an ear, let him hear what the **Spirit** says to the churches.

Rev 3:22 He who has an ear, let him hear what the **Spirit** says to the churches."

Rev 4:2 At once I was in the Spirit, and there before me was a throne in heaven with someone sitting on it.

Rev 14:13 Then I heard a voice from heaven say, "Write: Blessed are the dead

who die in the Lord from now on." "Yes," says the Spirit, "they will rest from their labor, for their deeds will follow them."

Rev 17:3 Then the angel carried me away in the Spirit into a desert. There I saw a woman sitting on a scarlet beast that was covered with blasphemous names and had seven heads and ten horns.

Rev 19:10 At this I fell at his feet to worship him. But he said to me, "Do not do it! I am a fellow servant with you and with your brothers who hold to the testimony of Jesus. Worship God! For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy."

Rev 21:10 And he carried me away in the Spirit to a mountain great and high, and showed me the Holy City, Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God.

Rev 22:17 The Spirit and the bride say, "Come!" And let him who hears say, "Come!" Whoever is thirsty, let him come; and whoever wishes, let him take the free gift of the water of life.
